PORTUGUESE 195– Senior Honors Independent Research

Purpose and Recognition:

The Senior Honors Program in the Department of Spanish & Portuguese is designed to encourage senior level students to excel in Portuguese and to provide recognition of outstanding scholastic achievement. Upon completing the requirements successfully, transcripts and diplomas will show the legend: **Distinction in the Major**.

Prerequisites and Requirements:

- Admission to the Portuguese seniors honors program.
- Overall grade point average of at least 3.00; 3.50 in the Portuguese major. Must have a minimum of 105 units, with a minimum of 30 upper-division units in the major.
- In order to get Distinction in the Major, students must be enrolled in Portuguese 195, "Senior Honors Independent research" during their senior year. It is recommended that students take Portuguese 199 Independent studies the previous quarter in order to do considerable research before writing your thesis in Portuguese 195
- The student will engage in research leading to a paper of considerable depth and complexity on a topic dealing with literature and/or language of Portugal, Brazil, or Portuguese speaking Africa.
- The topic of the paper will be from the student's field of interest, presented to a faculty of their choice (depending of specialty of topic) for initial approval. Meetings between faculty and student will be scheduled on a regular basis.
- Final submission of the paper will be presented to the Honors committee, consisting of the Chair, Senior Honors Faculty Advisor and sponsored faculty. If accepted, paper will be filed and the student will receive "Distinction in the Major" on their diploma. Student must submit a copy of their final paper to the Spanish & Portuguese undergraduate advising office.

Portuguese 195 cannot be used as an UD elective in the Portuguese Major or Minor
