Carlos Nuñez is one of Galicia's most revered artists, undisputed as the tradition's greatest piper. He is also enormously popular across the rest of Spain and throughout Europe and Latin America. His records regularly attain gold and platinum status in Spain, while worldwide he has sold over a million albums. He is already known in Irish music thanks to his early "adoption" by **The Chieftains** (so close was his musical and personal connection he was dubbed "The Seventh Chieftain").

His *Discover*, 2-CD released on September 25th, showcases the range and depth of this groundbreaking instrumentalism, who has taken Galician music to all corners of the world.
